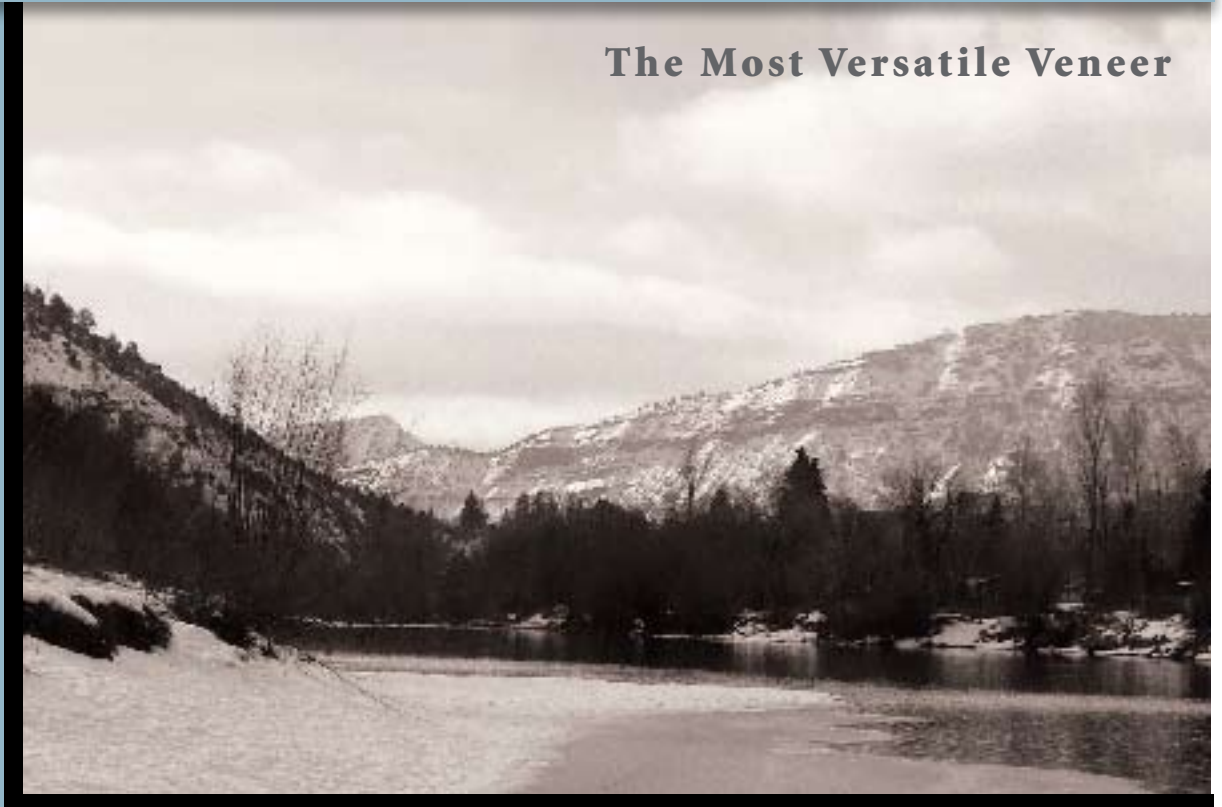

## **Course Title:      The Most Versatile Veneer**

### **Course Synopsis:**

Porcelain Veneers started to grow as a product exponentially when the first esthetic institute opened in 1995. As dentists began to be trained in these techniques, patients became more aware of them as well. These initial esthetic restorations involved the removal of significant tooth structure, typically all of the facial enamel. Post-operative sensitivity, veneer de-bonding and marginal leakage left dentists wondering if there might be a more conservative way. This course demonstrates the proper use of no-prep veneers and shows why the minimal prep veneer is the most versatile veneer of all.

### **Course Objectives:**

After completing this program, the dental professional should be able to:

- 1) Recognize the various veneer treatment modalities available to the modern practitioner to help them restore the mouth predictably.
- 2) Be familiar with the use of more conservative all-ceramic restorations such as no-prep and minimal prep porcelain veneers.
- 3) Be familiar with no-prep veneers and when it is appropriate to use them in conjunction with other restorations.
- 4) Be familiar with diagnostic wax-ups, the three main uses of them, and how to utilize them for temporizing minimal prep cases when necessary .

Dr. DiTolla graduated from the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry with honors in 1988. He was awarded his Fellowship in the Academy of General Dentistry in 1995.

Dr. DiTolla is a graduate of the Las Vegas Institute of Cosmetic Dentistry, and is also a clinical evaluator for CRA. In 2001, he became Director of Clinical Research and Education at Glidewell Labs, giving him an intimate knowledge of American dentists and their crown and bridge habits. While writing for several journals, Dr. DiTolla has a monthly column on restorative dentistry in *Dental Economics* and is a contributing editor for *Contemporary Esthetics and Restorative Practice*.

Dr. DiTolla recently helped launch *Chairside Magazine* and is the Clinical Editor of this quarterly publication that frequently presents his own clinical case studies.
